As I'm sure you are aware, homework is an essential part of the curriculum at Bishop Bridgeman and is set so that pupils can develop interest into areas that we are currently studying.

So far this year we have been trialling a new homework system in which children would complete a pre task, mid task and end project.

Whilst this way of setting homework has given children the opportunity to spend extended periods of time on homework, general feedback has shown that parents and children would prefer to have homework set on a weekly basis.
