

BREAKFAST CLUB

The breakfast club start time has changed to 8.00 am with some changes on how it operates.

Those children in Years 1, 2 and 3 will enter school through the main entrance (front door) and will be signed in as usual by a member of staff. These children will receive their breakfast first followed by games and activities.

The children in Years 4, 5 and 6 will be signed in at the KS2 gate/Year 3 entrance (left hand side gate as you enter the school grounds). These children will first of all take part in a physical sport activity with sports provider before going into breakfast club at 8.30 am.

No child will be allowed into school after 8.30 am. Any child arriving after this time, with the exception of Year 6 who can walk to school alone, will need to be supervised by a parent until school starts at 8.55 am.

Please donate something from the list below:






Here are some of the children from Year 1 drawing pictures to show fairness and kindness to each other.
