## PARENT APP

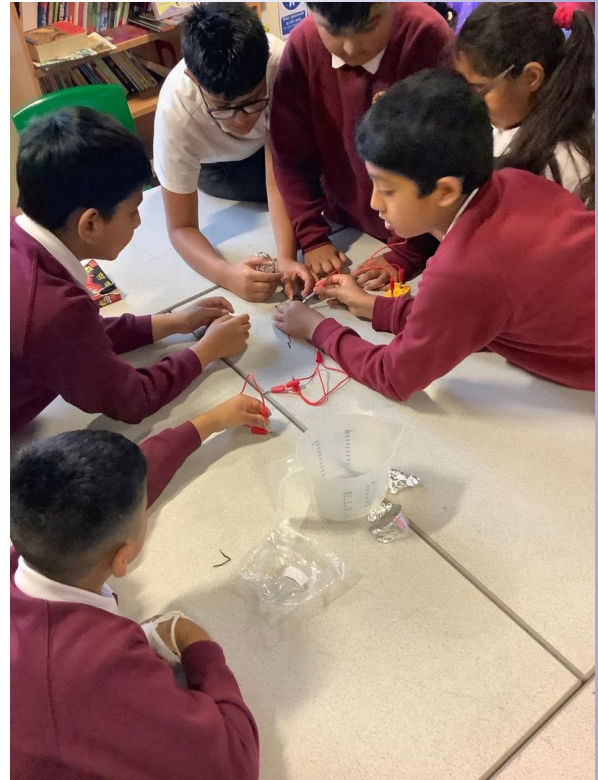
We will be moving to our new school app to communicate with all parents via email soon. If you have not already done so, please return your consent form to give school permission to move your personal data to the new system.

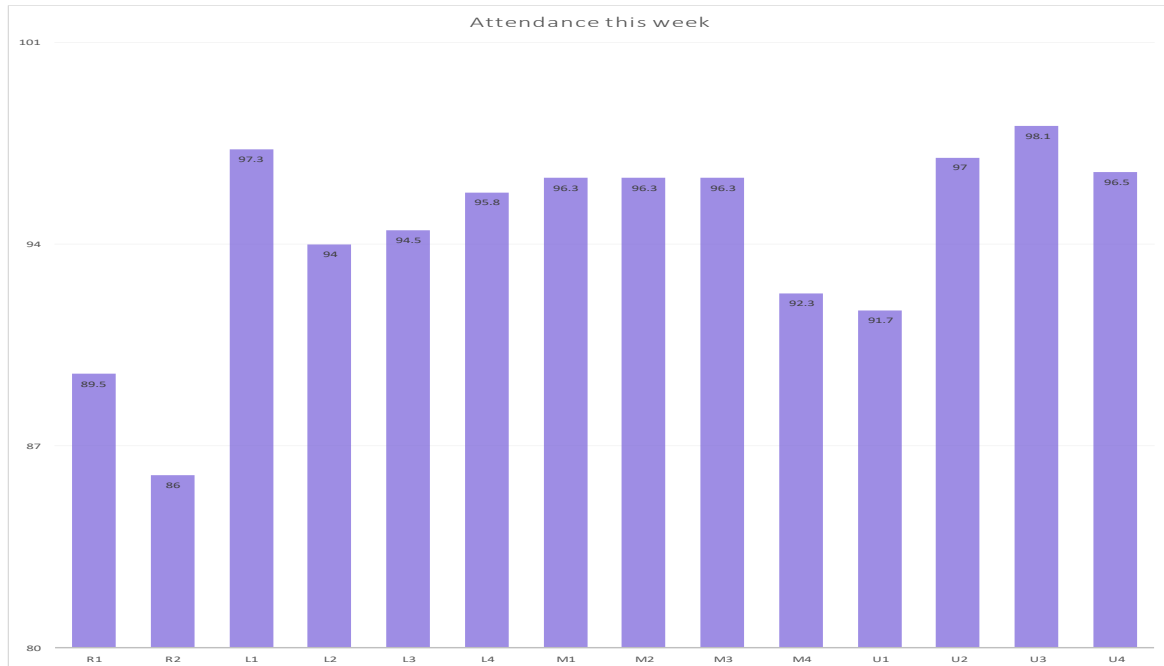
